Call for Abstracts

Abstract submission guidelines.

Participants who would like to present an ORAL or **POSTER PRESENTATION** must submit an abstract for consideration by the Scientific Committee.

Abstracts should be submitted in English and arrive no later than **Thursday, May 20, 2010.**

All abstracts related to ultra sound guided regional anaesthesia or use of ultra sound in any aspect of clinical medicine must be submitted and presented in clear English with accurate grammar and spelling of a quality suitable for publication

Only abstracts of authors who have paid their registration fees by **Monday, May 31st, 2010** will be scheduled for presentation

The first author is expected to attend the congress and present the poster or oral presentation.

The Scientific Committee will determine whether abstracts will be accepted poster presentations. The best 5 posters will be chosen for oral presentations.

The best oral presentation will win a prize of **£500** and the second best will win a prize of **£200.**

The abstract text including title and graphs must not exceed 1 side of A4.
Maximum words allowed-

Title - 20 in Uppercase

Body of abstract – 300 words.

1. Title: Times New Roman font 14 point in bold

2. Authors: 12 points

- A. Presenting author's contact details; include full mailing address, office hours phone number and email address of senior author
- B. Author or authors' names: initial(s) of first name(s), family name
- C. Affiliation details of all authors: department; institution / hospital; city; country

3. Abstract text. Abstracts must use the following structured format:

- i. Background and aims
- ii. Methods
- iii. Results
- iv. Conclusions

Apart from the title all text should be single spaced in Times New Roman font 12 points.

All graphs should be embedded as JPEG of 500 KB format into the document. Each picture will be counted for 50 words. Maximum of one table of up to 10 columns X 10 rows per poster is allowed.

Please note that Free presentation times will be ten (10) minutes including questions
